Nature Exploring – learn about the plants and trees that reside at Forest Home Farms through your 5-Senses

All About Forest Home Farms – this tour provides the background and history of Forest Home Farms, the City's 16-acre historic property that is on the National Register of Historic Places.

Boy/Girl Scout Badge(s) – a program may be tailored to meet the requirements of the badge.

Glass House - take a tour of the home and age appropriate hands-on activities conducted by trained, costumed docents. Children will develop a better understanding of daily life in a Victorian era farm house from the mid to late 1800's through 1910 in the San Ramon Valley.
