

CITY OF ARCADIA ORDINANCE #2019-7
An Ordinance Regulating Hours of Operation for Premises Licensed to Sell Alcohol Beverages
in the City of Arcadia, Wisconsin

ENACTED October 2, 2019

The following is a summary of Ordinance #2019-7, in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 62.11(4)(c):

City of Arcadia Ordinance #2019-7 amends Section 140-12 of the City of Arcadia Code of Ordinances which regulates hours of operation for premises licensed to sell alcohol beverages in the City of Arcadia. The amendment permits grocery stores, convenience stores, and nationwide department stores which sell alcohol beverages for offsite consumption to remain open but not sell alcohol beverages during restricted hours. Ordinance #2019-7 also expands the specific exceptions that allow certain businesses which are licensed to sell alcohol beverages for onsite consumption to remain open but not sell alcohol beverages during restricted hours. This Ordinance will take effect on the day after the date of publication of this summary.

ORDINANCE 2019-7

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING HOURS OF OPERATION FOR PREMISES LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOL BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF ARCADIA, WISCONSIN.

The Common Council of the City of Arcadia, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 140-12 of the City of Arcadia Code of Ordinances is amended to read:

“A. No premises for which an alcohol beverage license has been issued shall remain open:

(1) If the premises has been issued a Class "A" retailer's license for the sale of fermented beverages, between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.

(2) If the premises has been issued a "Class A" retailer's license for the sale of intoxicating liquors, between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

B. Notwithstanding Subsection A(1) above, grocery stores, convenience stores, and nationwide department stores may remain open but may not sell fermented malt beverages between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. Notwithstanding Subsection A(2) above, grocery stores, convenience stores, and nationwide department stores may remain open but may not sell intoxicating liquors between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

C. No premises for which an alcohol beverage license has been issued shall remain open:

(1) If a retail Class "B" or "Class B" license, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and on Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., except that on January 1 premises operating under such licenses are not required to close. Between the hours of 12 midnight and 6:00 a.m. no alcohol beverages may be sold in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises.

D. Hotels and restaurants whose principal business is the furnishing of food or lodging to patrons, bowling alleys, movie theaters, painting studios, indoor golf and baseball facilities, indoor horseshoe pitching facilities, curling clubs, and golf courses and golf clubhouses, may remain open for the conduct of their regular business but no intoxicating liquors or fermented malt beverages shall be sold during the hours set out in Subsection C(1) above."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance #2019-7 shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
