

ORDINANCE #2018-8

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 360 OF THE CITY OF ARCADIA
CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE
CITY OF ARCADIA, WISCONSIN**

The Common Council of the City of Arcadia, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 360-14(C.) of City of Arcadia Code of Ordinances is re-created to read as follows:

“C. Right Turns.

- (1) An operator of any vehicle traveling westbound on Cleveland Street may make a right turn without stopping at the corner of Cleveland Street and Commercial Street.”

SECTION 2. Section 360-14(D.) of City of Arcadia Code of Ordinances is created to read as follows:

“Miscellaneous lane and turn controls. The Common Council, or a committee or person appointed by the Mayor, subject to approval from the Common Council, with the input of the Chief of Police, is authorized, when in its judgment the safety of the situation requires, to place official traffic control devices within or adjacent to intersections directing that a different course from that specified in § 346.31, Wis. Stats., be travelled by vehicles turning at the intersection and to mark lines for traffic designating separate lanes for slow moving traffic or for traffic moving in a particular direction.”

SECTION 3. All other provisions of Chapter 360 of the City of Arcadia Code of Ordinances not affected by this Ordinance are ratified, confirmed and approved and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
