T-shirts are available on a limited basis for late and day-of registrants. Additional T-shirts may be purchased on event day for \$10 each.

DOG TROT RULES OF PARTICIPATION

- Dogs must be current on vaccinations.
- No aggressive dogs.
- No female dogs in heat.
- No more than two dogs per human.
- Keep your dog on a 7-foot leash or shorter at all times.
- No dogs under the age of six months.
- Bring your dog only if he/she is well socialized.
- Clean up after your dog.
- Run or walk the course only if you and your pet are in adequate physical condition.
- Strollers are welcome on the course
- Route will close after 90-minutes.
- All participants must have their race bib on the FRONT of their person.
- Participants must run/walk with a dog to be eligible for awards.
- Participants may not switch distances after May 17.

AWARDS

Awards will be distributed to the top participant in the following categories. Results won't be final until noon on Tuesday, May 23.

- Child (8 & under)
- Tween (9-12 years)
- Teen (13-19 years)
- Adult I (20-35 years)
- Adult II (36-54 years)
- Senior (55+)

Participants must run/walk with a dog and complete the route in its entirety to be eligible for awards. Awards will be available for pick-up at the Auburn Community & Event Center starting May 24. Winners will be notified by email and given further pick-up instructions.

Take Highway 18 East. Take the Auburn-Enumclaw Exit. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Auburn Way South. Continue south on Auburn Way. At the intersection of M Street, be in the right hand lane to take Howard Road. At the end of Howard Road, take a right onto R Street SE. Continue through the light at 29th Street SE. Take a left into Game Farm Park.
