POLICY: Ultra Violet Lights	POLICY NO: 20

PURPOSE:

To provide residents who experience water quality problems in their on site wells, with monetary compensation towards the installation of Ultra Violet Disinfection Lights.

PROCESS FOR APPLICATION AND APPROVAL:

Residents who submit proof of poor water quality by way of providing two consecutive water sample results showing levels of coliform above the acceptable parameters allowed in the Canadian drinking water guidelines, or any level of ecoli, within a one month period, will be deemed eligible for compensation from a fund set up to address such occurrences.

POLICY:

Upon receipt of proof of poor water quality as described above and, upon submission from the homeowner, copies of all invoices pertaining to the purchase and installation of a Ultra Violet disinfection system, The Stratford Utility Corporation will pay the registered owner of the property on which the affected well is located, the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars in the form of cheque only. The money available for this contribution will be drawn from a water and sewer fund set up by the Town to address problems in areas where servicing is not yet available to the property owner.

EXCEPTIONS AND EXCLUSIONS:

The Stratford Utility will **not** pay invoices submitted for **any** used device or for **any** work performed by an unlicensed contractor. Invoicing must be marked "paid" and be issued from a registered trade contractor.
