

Notice of Study Completion

St. Thomas Transportation Master Plan Update

In April 2020, the City of St. Thomas began the process of updating its Transportation Master Plan (TMP) to serve as a long-range strategic plan for the City. The TMP assessed existing transportation challenges and opportunities and recommended policies to promote an efficient, multi-modal transportation network that fosters vehicular, bicycle, pedestrian, and transit mobility.

The study identified the City's transportation improvement needs through the year 2041 and provided recommendations to improve the operational, design, and transportation policies that St. Thomas uses to manage its transportation infrastructure.

The Process

The TMP was undertaken in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Master Planning process, within the Municipal Engineers Association (2000, as amended 2007, 2011 and 2015). The TMP provides the framework for future projects that may require further detailed studies under the Municipal Class EA.

Notice of Review Period

A TMP report has been prepared that documents the TMP study. This notice announces the start of the 30 calendar-day review period for the TMP in accordance with the requirements of the EA process.
