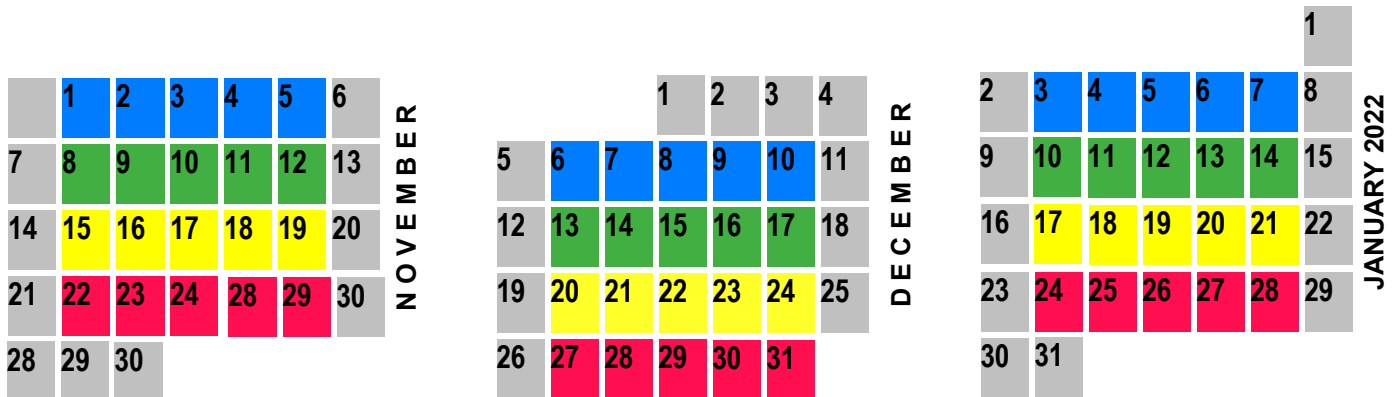


2021-2022 BRUSH CHIPPING INFORMATION

The City of Plymouth Department of Municipal Services will continue to provide year round brush chipping. We will be in your area once per month to pick up limbs and branches at the curb. No city bags or tags are required for brush pick up. Additionally, there is no need to notify Municipal Services of limbs at the curb.

Please refer to the calendar below and the map on the reverse side to determine the assigned week for your address. This service is not intended for tree contractors, but rather for residents who have trimmed limbs from their trees or have branches that fell due to storm damage. The following guidelines will make it safe for our crews to retrieve your brush. If crews are unable to safely pick up your items, you will be notified.

- Place brush at curb before 7:00 AM on the Monday of your designated week
- Place brush neatly at the curb, stacked all in one direction, with the cut end facing towards oncoming traffic
- Limb length must be at least 3 feet long – smaller sticks and twigs can be placed in a brown Kraft lawn refuse bag or can marked “compost” to be collected on your regular trash day
- There is no maximum length for brush and branches to be chipped
- Brush pile cannot be taller than 5 feet in height
- Root balls must be cleared of all dirt in order to be picked up
- Limbs with thorns and vines or vine like weeds cannot be chipped — place them in a brown Kraft lawn refuse bag or can marked “compost” to be collected on your regular trash day
- Ensure there are no vehicles blocking brush piles so crews can safely access the pile
- Keep brush removed from any legal, marked parking spots
- Keep brush piles separate from bulk leaf piles during the fall season
- The schedule is subject to change due to city staffing levels, equipment, weather events, etc.



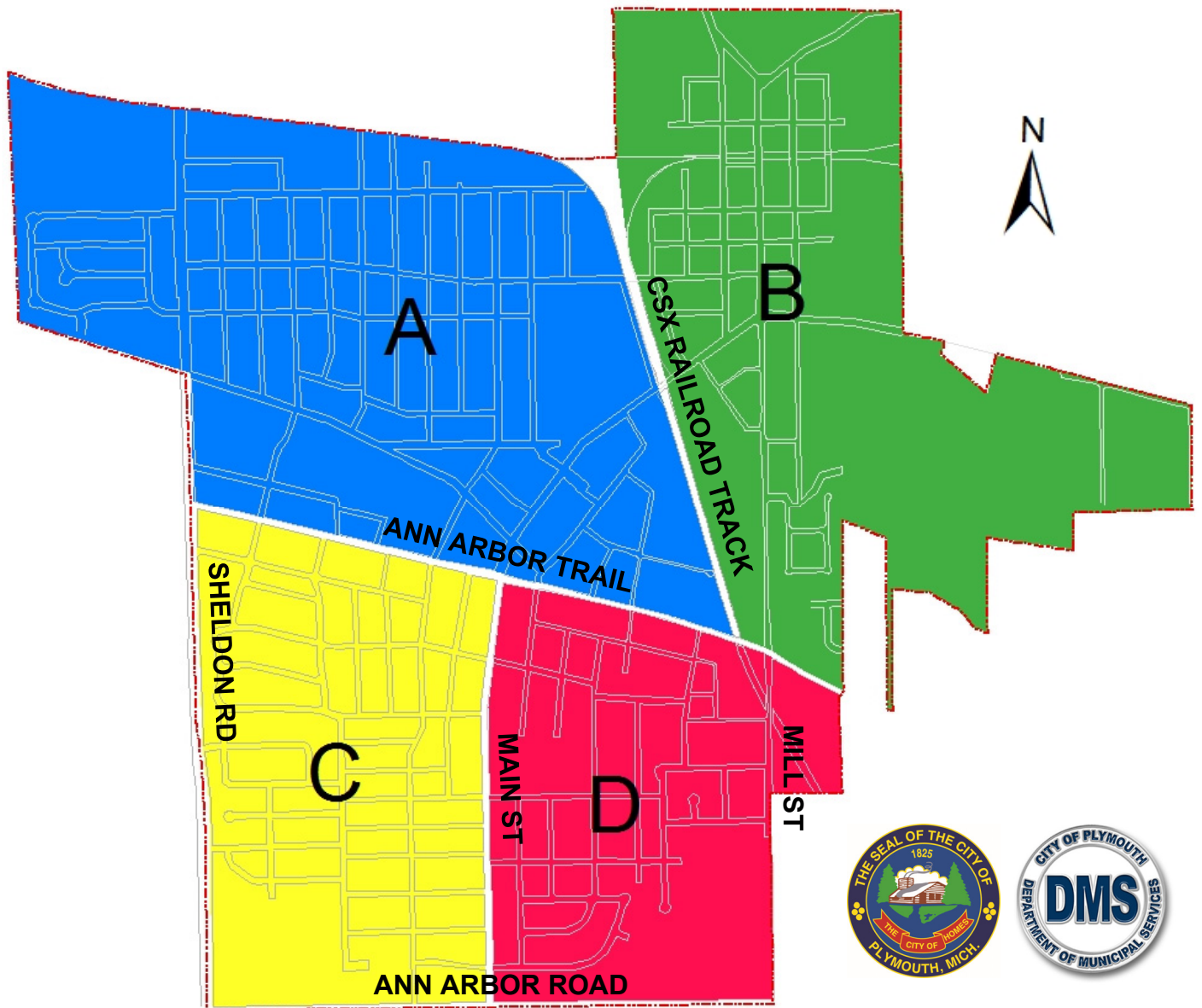
- AREA **A** (Blue)

Residents may place Christmas trees curbside for pick up as part of the brush chipping program. Please remove all lights, ornaments, garland, tinsel, other decorations, tree stands, etc. Christmas trees will be chipped at your curbside so please don't put trees in a bag.

North of ANN ARBOR TRAIL, West of CSX RAILROAD TRACK	AREA A	First full week of the month
North of ANN ARBOR TRAIL, East of CSX RAILROAD TRACK	AREA B	Second full week of the month
South of ANN ARBOR TRAIL, West of MAIN ST	AREA C	Third full week of the month
South of ANN ARBOR TRAIL, East of MAIN ST	AREA D	Fourth full week of the month
