You have the right to make a complaint against a police officer for any improper police conduct. California law requires this agency to have a procedure to investigate citizen complaints. You have the right to a written description of this procedure. This agency may find after the investigation that there is not enough evidence to warrant action on your complaint. Even if that is the case, you have the right to make a complaint and have it investigated if you believe an officer, or a member of the staff, acted improperly. Citizen complaints and any reports or findings related to complaints must be retained by this agency for five (5) years. Comments, different from complaints, will be retained by this agency for two (2) years.

It is against the law to make a complaint that you know to be false. If you make a complaint against an officer knowing it to be false, you can be prosecuted for a misdemeanor crime.
