

The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Wednesday, May 2, 2018 in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 10:10 A.M. Ralph Orzo, Secretary, made the invocation.

The Board and registrar welcomed Dr. Betty Bibbins, chief of Precinct 0465, to the Canvass.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting held on April 5, having been reviewed by the board were approved and signed. The Board and registrar conducted the Canvass of Votes for the May 1, 2018, May Towns General Election.

Board reviewed the Configuration Database for the Electronic Pollbooks and flash drives and the Configuration Database for the voting machines. A listing of each signed by the board is filed with the materials for May 1, 2018, May Towns General Election.

A certified copy of the Abstracts of Votes is attached hereto and incorporated in these minutes. The Board directed the Secretary to transmit certified copies of the Abstracts of Votes cast to the State Board of Elections, the Administrator of the County of Northampton, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court, and the Town Clerks of Cape Charles, Cheriton, and Exmore.

Board and registrar discussed the plan to move District 0401 Polling Place to Johnson's United Methodist Church Social Hall. Registrar will call and arrange a walk-through and ADA compliance survey of the building.

Board and Registrar briefly discussed the training and Logic and Accuracy testing for the June 12, 2018, Dual Primary. Logic and Accuracy testing will be held on June 6 at 10:00a.m.

Chairman moved that the Board meet on May 8, 2018, at 9:30 A.M. at Johnson's United Methodist Church Social Hall with a meeting to follow. All present voted yes. Motion was unanimously passed.
