

The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Thursday, May 8, 2018 in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 10:15 A.M. Ralph Orzo, Chair, made the invocation.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting held on May 2, having been reviewed by the board were approved and signed.

Board reviewed the roster of Officers of Election for the June 12, 2018, Dual Primary. After discussion, a tentative list was made. Motion to accept was made by Secretary Clark, was seconded by Cahir Orzo and unanimously approved. A copy of the final list is hereto attached to these minutes.

Training of the Officers of Election for the June 12, 2018, Dual Primary was discussed. It was decided that only those precinct teams who did not have a town election, precincts 3 and 4, would receive the mock election training at the Bingo Hall. The other precincts, 1, 2, and 5, would be trained using a quiz and discussion format in the Board Chambers.

Board and registrar discussed the two items that would go before the Board of Supervisors. The first item is the redrawing the district lines of districts 0401 and 0201 to include in District 0401 the 17 voters in District 0201 who are now Eastville residents and therefore need to be in the same district as the rest of Eastville voters. The second item is the request to move the District 0401 polling place from the Former Middle School Gym to Johnson's United Methodist Church. Previous to the meeting, Board and registrar met with Mrs. Kidwell of Johnson's United to tour the facility. It was agreed it would make an appropriate polling location.

Chairman moved that the Board meet on June 6, 2018, at 9:00 A.M. and then remain for Logic and Accuracy Testing. All present voted yes. Motion was unanimously passed.

Board adjourned the meeting at 11:40 a.m.
