

The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Tuesday, September 6, 2018 in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 1:15 P.M. Ralph Orzo, Chair, made the invocation.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting held on August 14, having been reviewed by the board were approved and signed.

Board and registrar discussed the upcoming election preparation schedule. Logic and Accuracy Testing for absentee equipment will be held at 10:30 on September 19; officer training will be held the week of October 15-19, and Logic and Accuracy Testing for precinct equipment will be held on October 25 at 11:00. The canvass for the November 6, 2018, General and Special Elections will be held beginning November 6<sup>th</sup>, and continuing until all provisional votes, if any, have been processed.

Board and registrar discussed a registration application that was denied because the applicant indicated no felony convictions, which was later disproved by VERIS. Voter was denied. Discussion centered on whether the applicant knowingly or inadvertently indicated a non-felon status. Board agreed the office acted correctly, but directed the registrar to seek guidance from the Commonwealth's Attorney on these situations going forward and implement a consistent strategy.

Chairman moved that the Board meet on September 6, 2018, at 10:30 A.M. All present voted yes. Motion was unanimously passed.

Board adjourned the meeting at 12:00 P.M.
