

The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Thursday, October 8, 2020, in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 10:49 A.M. Ralph Orzo made the invocation.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting on September 3, 2020 having been reviewed by the Board were approved and signed.

Registrar presented Board with a list of officers for the November 3, 2020, General and Special Election. Board unanimously approved. A list is hereto attached to these minutes.

Registrar updated that he ordered another 1350 ballots at the direction of ELECT. Our ballot order now stands at 115% of ballots per voters.

Registrar and Board discussed the logistics of Election Day. As usual we will all meet in the office at 4:30 in the morning to transport equipment and ballots the precincts. Board will then work in shifts throughout the day. Board will collect all voted absentee ballots that arrive at the polls in three shifts, one in the morning, then early afternoon, then after 5:30 Election Night.

Board adjourned the meeting at 12:00 p.m. after unanimously agreeing to meet for the November 3, 2020, General and Special Elections canvass at 10:30, November 4, 2020.
