

The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Thursday, July 7, 2022, in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 10:35 A.M. A moment of silence was observed.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting on June 2, 2022 having been reviewed by the Board were approved and signed.

Registrar and Board discussed the June 21, 2022 Republican Primary. All agreed that things ran smoothly for a low turnout election. Discussion then turned to concern about the number of Officers of Election that were available for this election. Registrar asked the Board to recruit from their parties, and said he would recruit officers this summer as well. Registrar also cited the need for chiefs and said we will have another Chief's Academy before the November election to build leadership capacity.

Registrar shared a FOIA request with Board that asked about certain voting machine functions, ballot paper source, and printing contracts. Registrar reported that he could only respond to some of the items requested because out voting machines are not the brand that can do the functions the FOIA mentioned.

The discussion with the interns was tabled because the interns could not make the meeting.

Board adjourned the meeting after unanimously agreeing to meet again at 10:30 A.M. on August 4th, 2022.
