ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1. Sealed Bids: Sealed bids for construction of the project entitled **Commerce WTP Pumping Improvements** will be received until 2:00 PM on December 10, 2020 in the Council Chambers at the Commerce City Hall located at 27 Sycamore Street, Commerce, GA 30529 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

2. Work To Be Done: The Work to be completed for the **Commerce WTP Pumping Improvements** is described briefly as follows:

The project will consist of finished water pumping improvements for the existing water treatment plant. Work will include, but is not limited to, installation of a new wetwell with two new pumps, and associated piping and electrical improvements, as well as erosion and sediment control measures and devices.

3. Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents: Copies of Bidding Documents may be obtained from ESG Engineering - contact Margaret Hildebrand at mhildebrand@esgengineering.com to procure Bidding Documents and to be added to the Bidder's List (required to bid on project). Digital documents will be provided upon a non-reimbursable payment of \$100 and hard copies will be provided upon non-reimbursable payment of \$200. **Prospective bidders must be on the official plan holders list in order for their bid to be considered responsive.**

4. Contractor License: Any Contractor submitting a bid must be licensed by the State of Georgia. See Instructions to Bidders for additional bidding requirements.

5. Bonds: Bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified cashier's check in an amount not less than 5% of the base bid. All bonds shall be by a surety company licensed in Georgia with an "A" minimum rating of performance and a financial strength of at least five (5) times the contract price as listed in the most current publication of "Best's Key Rating Guide Property Liability". Performance and Payment Bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price shall be required of the successful bidder if contract is awarded. Each Bond shall be accompanied by a "Power of Attorney" authorizing the attorney-in-fact to bind the surety and certified to include the date of the bond.

6. Funding: This project is being funded by the City of Commerce.

7. Reservation of Rights: Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including without limitation, the rights to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced or conditional Bids and to reject the Bid of any Bidder if Owner believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder, whether because the Bid is not responsive or the Bidder is unqualified or of doubtful financial ability or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by the Owner.

8. All permits required for the construction of this project are expected to be approved prior to the date of the bid opening.

9. There are no easements required for this project.
