



DEMOLITION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

Electronic submittal required - upload and submit all documents and plans with completed web application. All documents shall be submitted as PDF files.

Site Plan - must show locations of existing and proposed structures, septic tank, drain field, and any other major physical features. Scale and North arrow, topography, and high water mark shall also be included on the plot plan.

Owner Authorization Form (if applicant is not the owner).

Erosion Control – indicate erosion control measures on site plan submittals.

Asbestos Survey

Asbestos Checklist (Please contact Puget Sound Clean Air Agency for all regulations)

- An asbestos survey conducted by a certified Asbestos Hazardous Emergency Response Act (AHERA) inspector.
- A completed Notice of Intent submitted to Puget Sound Clean Air Agency for all demolition projects 120 square feet and greater.
- A copy of the asbestos survey and Notice of Intent (to be kept on site and available for review by inspection personnel).
- All asbestos-containing materials (ACM) must be removed in accordance with Puget Sound Clean Air Agency regulations by individuals trained with Washington Labor & Industries or Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards.
- Perform a walk through prior to demolition to ensure all ACM identified on Puget Sound Clean Air Agency's asbestos survey have been removed.
