

## INVITATION TO BID

### CITY OF EDMONDS

**Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk at 121 Fifth Avenue North, Edmonds, Washington, until 2:00 PM, September 6, 2022**, for the construction of the SEAVIEW PARK INFILTRATION FACILITY PHASE 2 E0FA / C546 and the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary for this project.

*This project will expand the capacity of an existing infiltration facility located at Seaview Park, 80th Ave W & 186th St SW, Edmonds, WA by adding an additional row of underground injection wells beneath a stormwater dispersion chamber and connecting it to the stormwater drainage system. Major project elements include excavation and backfill for storm pipe, catch basins, a stormwater pre-treatment structure, HMA pavement restoration, infiltration well construction, and connection to existing stormwater system.*

- **Pre-bid Meeting – Informational meeting will be held on August 30, 2022 at 1:30 PM via live internet stream and concurrent conference call. The meeting will consist of a short presentation going over important project elements and a Q&A session.**

### **PROCEDURAL CHANGES DUE TO COVID-19 CONCERNS**

Edmonds City Hall is closed to all visitors as a precaution to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. In order to provide a fair and transparent bidding process, the following procedures will be in place.

- **Bid Submittal – Russell Lynch, the City’s project manager, will be available outside the City Hall main entrance (121 5th Ave North, Edmonds, WA) to receive sealed bids beginning at 1:45 on Tuesday, September 6, 2022. Bidders who arrive before this time shall call Russell Lynch at (425) 771-0220 and arrange to meet him at City Hall to drop-off their sealed bid.**

A certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount equal to at least five percent of the total amount of bid, including sales tax if applicable, must accompany each bid as evidence of good faith and as a guarantee that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will execute the contract and give a performance and payment bond as required. The check will be given as a guarantee that the bidder shall execute the contract in conformity with the contract documents if it is awarded to him and shall provide a performance and payment bond as specified therein within ten calendar days after notification of the award of contract to the bidder.

The City of Edmonds reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive irregularities or informalities in the bid or in the bidding. No bidder may withdraw his bid after the hour set for the opening thereof or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding sixty calendar days.

The City of Edmonds, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252,42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

It is anticipated that this project will be funded in part by the Washington State Department of Ecology. Neither the State of Washington nor any of its departments or employees are, or shall be, a party to any contract or any subcontract resulting from this solicitation for bids.
