EDMONDS (HPC) HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION SEEKS NEW MEMBER

(Edmonds - WA) The City of Edmonds is seeking a resident or potentially a nonresident to fill the open professional position on the Edmonds Historic Preservation Commission (HPC). Qualified professional candidates will have experience in identifying, evaluating and protecting historic resources and a background in any of the following disciplines: history, architecture, architectural history, historic preservation, planning, cultural anthropology, archaeology, cultural geography, American studies, law and/or real estate.

The HPC serves as an advisory Commission with the responsibility to identify and actively encourage the conservation of the city's historic resources by initiating and maintaining a register of historic places and reviewing proposed changes to register properties; to raise community awareness of the city's history and historic resources; and to serve as the city's primary resource in matters of historic planning and preservation. The commission, with support from city staff, meets on the second Thursday of each month at 5:30 p.m.
