NOTICE OF UNANTICIPATED VACANCY **PARKS, RECREATION, AND SOCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION**

The City of Lawndale is inviting interested residents to apply for appointment to the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission (Commission) to fill a vacancy. The Mayor and City Council will consider the appointment of one new member to serve until February 28, 2023.

This five-member Commission has the following duties and responsibilities:

- The Commission advises the City Council regarding community activities and programs for youth, families and senior citizens, including the operation of current facilities and development of new facilities.
- The Commission is responsible for assisting the City Council and the Community Services Department in identifying and assessing social and leisure needs in the community, and identifying service gaps and areas of duplication within the community.
- The Commission encourages maximum availability of social and leisure opportunities through appropriate scheduling of facilities and promotion of citizen participation.

To qualify for appointment, you must be at least 18 years of age and must have been a resident of Lawndale for at least 30 consecutive days prior to submitting the application for appointment. Applications are available at Lawndale City Hall, 14717 Burin Avenue, the Community Center, 14700 Burin Avenue, and on the city's website, www.lawndalecity.org. Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's Department and will be accepted until the position is filled.
