Note: Bond Accompanying Bid - to be executed by the Bidder and the surety company. The amount of this bond shall be not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid, including sales tax, if applicable, and may be shown in dollars or on a percentage basis.

Description of Work: The City of Des Moines Marina is replacing the south boarding float string at the Redondo Beach Boat Launching Ramp and is seeking a contractor to build the six (6) 5 ft. X 18 ft. and three (3) 5 ft. X 24 ft. float units that, when connected together, will make up the 5 ft. X 180 ft. boarding float system on the south side of the launching ramp. The individual float units are to be constructed as shown and described in the plans and specifications posted in the City's on-line plan room, www.bxwa.com. The completed float units are to be delivered to the City of Des Moines Marina at the address shown below and will be installed at the site at the appropriate time by Marina staff.

Project Location: The new floats will be installed at the Redondo Boat Ramp located at 28280 Redondo Beach Drive South but the City anticipates that the new float sections will be built at the successful bidders' place of business and delivered to:

There will not be a scheduled pre-bid walk thru but Marina staff will be available to show potential bidders the site where the floats will be installed if requested.

Access to bidding information (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is available through City of Des Moines' on-line plan room. Free-of-charge access is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors,

and Vendors by going to www.bxwa.com and clicking on “Posted Projects”; “Public Works”; “City of Des Moines.” This on-line plan room provides Bidders with fully usable on-line documents; with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free on-line digitizer/takeoff tool. Bidders must “Register” in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the “Self-Registered Bidders List”. Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project. This is a Public Works Project which is subject to Prevailing Wage and Sales Tax rules. A current City of Des Moines Business License is required for all contractors and subcontractors that perform work under this contract. These licenses shall be in place prior to the issuance of any Notice to Proceed on this project. Retainage will be withheld.

The City of Des Moines hereby notifies all bidders that bids submitted in response to this invitation will not be subjected to discrimination on the grounds of race, color, creed, sex or national origin in consideration for an award.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities in the bidding and to make the award as deemed to be in the best interest of the City. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty days after the date set for the bid opening.

All schedules on the Proposal must be completed or the bid shall be considered non-responsive. Basis for award shall be Total Bid for all Schedules included in the Proposal.
