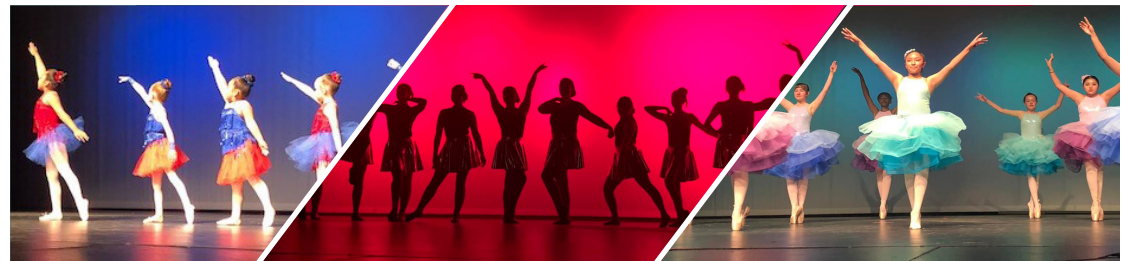

Aurora Dance Arts, a City of Aurora Cultural Services program, offers professional dance instruction in a variety of styles for children of all ages. Classes are held at city of Aurora recreational facilities: Expo, Meadowood, and Central Recreation Centers.

The Continuous Dance Program for students ages 3-20 is a comprehensive, 9-month program with classes in ballet, pointe, tap, jazz, contemporary hip hop, poms, and lyrical. Instructors implement an established dance syllabus for beginning through advanced level classes designed to grow with your child. Classes commence Sept. 6 and run through end of May 2023. Students must register by Dec. 1 to participate in these classes.

Registration for fall is open as of Aug. 1 at 9 a.m.

REGISTRATION AND CLASS PLACEMENT

Registration for the Continuous Dance Program is done via phone call to the Dance Office. Children are placed in classes based on age, ability and technique level. Classes are arranged sequentially so that students progress through the program safely, without gaps in their training, and are well-prepared for the next technique level. Instructors may recommend a transfer to another class (up or down a level) based on ability and the best interest of the student. **Students should expect to spend 2-3 years in any given level/style in this program for proper development.**

MONTHLY TUITION & COSTUME FEES

- Monthly tuition for Aurora residents ranges in price from \$32 to \$44 per month, per class, and is dependent on the length of classes. Please see the website for specific fee information.
- Discounts offered for dancers enrolled in multiple classes and/or families with multiple children enrolled. Please visit the Aurora Dance Arts website for full pricing details.
- Non-residents of Aurora pay slightly higher, but still reasonably priced, tuition fees.
- Costume fees apply for participation in the Continuous Program/Spring Dance Recital. Costumes range from \$50-\$60 per class, and a 50% deposit for costume fees is paid at time of registration.
