- All recyclable materials conveniently together in one container.
- · Cardboard may be broken down if needed to fit in recycle container.
- · Do not force materials into recycling container. It may not empty completely.
- · Please be sure all containers are emptied of food and liquid prior to recycling.

### New in your Blue!

The following items have been added to our Single-Stream Recycling Program:

- Large Rigid Plastics such as, five gallon buckets, laundry baskets, crates, plastic toys and outdoor play equipment.
- Clean, dry & bagged plastic bags. This includes dry cleaner bags, grocery bags, produce bags, newspaper bags, and bubble wrap. Please make sure to keep them clean & dry and always bag them up and tie securely.
