Good afternoon, Bob:

You are correct. I was citing the former numbers. The bases for denial in this matter are pursuant to currently-numbered ORS 192.345(3) and ORS 192.345(1). The public body need not evaluate whether the disclosure would "affect" the prosecution or defense. There are multiple reasons why public dissemination of investigative information or materials can adversely affect a criminal prosecution (including the criminal defendant's constitutional rights) or a prospective civil case.
