

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 16-06-21-05

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING LANE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL LANDS ACCESS PROGRAM FUNDING, AUTHORIZING COMMITMENT OF MATCHING FUNDS, AND IF SUCCESSFUL, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE ASSOCIATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS, FOR FIVE COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners Strategic Plan focuses on three Priorities, specifically a Safe, Healthy County, Vibrant Communities, and Infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to seek grant opportunities in pursuit of these priorities, including to help defray the costs of maintaining the County Road system in safe, working order; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Federal Lands Access Program is soliciting project proposals for federal fiscal years 2019-2021; and

WHEREAS, Lane County has identified the following four projects to submit for proposed funding:

1. Row River Road deep culvert replacements, mile points 5.96, 7.02, 7.37, and 8.72, \$1.3 million total estimated cost;
2. Row River Trail remaining county road crossings at Layng Road mile point 0.74 and Row River Road mile point 11.0, \$362,000 total estimated cost;
3. London Road culvert replacements at mile point 4.60 (Williams Creek) and 5.82 (Cedar Creek) and overlay from mile points 3.520 to 6.730, \$1.725 million total estimated cost;
4. Kitson Springs Road slide repair, 100% design and construction, MP 2.5-2.75, \$3.6 million total estimated cost; and
5. North Fork Siuslaw Road, slide repair, mile point 15.75, \$2 million total estimated cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Lane County Public Works is authorized to submit funding applications to apply for these five projects, committing Lane County to allocate a minimum of 10.27% match, with in-kind design and construction engineering, and other associated in-kind work, to be paid for by the County Road Fund for each of the respective projects, if funded; and,
2. If any of the grants are approved, the County Administrator is authorized to execute associated intergovernmental agreements to proceed with the project(s) and for the County to be reimbursed through the grant program.


