**WHEREAS**, State of Oregon, Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Addictions and Mental Health Division (AMH) requires Local Mental Health Authorities to submit a Biennial Mental Health and Addictions Implementation Plan every two years; and

**WHEREAS**, Health and Human Services staff conducted a community needs assessment and determined priority areas as required by the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the plan priorities were reviewed and approved by the Mental Health Advisory Committee, the Prevention Subcommittee of the Public Safety Coordinating Council, and the Clinical Advisory Sub-Committee of the Coordinated Care Organization; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Lane County, through the Department of Health and Human Services, is approved to submit the 2019-2021 Biennial Mental Health and Addictions Implementation Plan (BIP) to Oregon Health Authority Addictions and Mental Health Division
