THE OREGON YOUTH AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, ORS 420.017 requires the concurrence of the governing body of the County, in the form of a Resolution; and


WHEREAS, The cited ORS further requires that the Plan be submitted with a letter of concurrence from the Presiding Circuit Court Judge; and

WHEREAS, The Plan hereby approved for submission has been reviewed by the Department of Health & Human Services and found to meet the OYA guidelines of a Plan that both addresses the reduction of juvenile recidivism and the use of beds in the OYA's Close Custody Facilities; as well as targeting local at-risk youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS and RESOLVES** as follows:

1. The 2021-2023 Juvenile Crime Prevention Basic and Diversion Services Plan is approved and the Department of Health & Human Services is authorized to submit the plan to the Oregon Youth Authority; and
2. The County Administrator is delegated authority to sign Plan documents, if required, prior to submission of the biennial Plan, for the 2021-2023 time frame.
