ORDER AND RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT  
OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE'S MULTI-  
UNIT PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION  
PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, the State of Oregon Statutes ORS 307.600 through 307.637 authorizes cities to establish and design programs to attract new development of multi-unit housing in eligible areas by means of a local property tax exemption; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 13, 2021 the City of Florence established a multi-unit property tax exemption (MUPTE) program in accordance with ORS 307.600 through 307.637; and


**WHEREAS**, the Florence MUPTE program shall become effective upon receipt of written support from a sufficient number of partner taxing jurisdictions whose combined levying authority exceeds 51%; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Florence has therefore sought the Lane County Board of Commissioners' written support of the Florence MUPTE program.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS and RESOLVES** as follows:

1. That Lane County is in support of the Florence MUPTE program.
2. That a copy of this order and resolution will be sent by the Lane County Board of Commissioners to the City of Florence.
