ORDER NO: 22-04-12-04

IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING A COMMUNITY  
BENEFITS BIDDING PROCESS FOR CAPITAL  
PROJECTS

**WHEREAS**, in December, 2019, the revised 2018-2021 Strategic Plan adopted by the Lane County Board of Commissioners incorporated a Key Strategic Initiative to develop and implement a policy for community benefits starting with Capital Projects to ensure projects maximize local impact; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Administrator directed County Capital Planning staff to prepare a proposed plan for implementing a community benefits program to be used on future capital facilities projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial plan and options, described as Community Benefits Bidding, were presented by County staff to the Board on September 29, 2020, and revised to incorporate the direction received from the Board;

**WHEREAS**, the Board approved implementation of the Community Benefits Bidding on October 6, 2020 per Board Order 20-10-20-06; and

**WHEREAS**, relying on the experience gained from completed and ongoing Community Benefits projects, the Board desires to expand and refine the Community Benefits Building Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The threshold amount for application of Community Benefits Program criteria to County building construction projects is changed to include all projects with an estimated value of \$500,000 or more, and
2. County staff are directed to incorporate disqualification and diversity participation elements into the Program.
