

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 22-05-03-02

In the Matter of Approving a Contract with DLR Group for Upgrades to the Lane County Adult Correctional Facility and delegating authority to the County Administrator to execute the contract.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has identified an immediate need for upgrades to security systems, fire and life safety systems, the reconfiguration of pre-trial services area, and the creation of non-contact visitation booths to improve safety and protect the health of employees, visitors, and Adults in Custody at the Lane County Adult Corrections facility; and

WHEREAS, the County commissioned a comprehensive needs analysis of the Lane County Adult Corrections facility, which was presented to the Board on October 8th, 2021 and detailed the security, health, and life safety issues that need to be addressed; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Sheriff's Office has been awarded funding through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to specifically address the needs identified above; and

WHEREAS, these funds must be allocated by December 31, 2024 and expended by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, County Administration in conjunction with the Sheriff's Office has selected through an RFP process an architecture/engineering team to create contract documents for the work to address the upgrades to security and facilities at the Lane County Adult Corrections;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. A contract in the amount of \$1,615,574 be awarded to DLR Group Architecture & Engineering Inc. for design and construction administration services associated with the Lane County Adult Correction Facilities and Technology upgrades; and
2. The County Administrator is delegated authority to execute the contract.
