

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 22-05-24-02

IN THE MATTER OF PROVIDING APPROVAL FOR THREE CONTRACT AMENDMENTS FUNDED BY IMPROVING CRIMINAL JUSTICE RESPONSES TO SEXUAL ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, DATING VIOLENCE AND STALKING GRANT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE AMENDMENTS.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners regards contracts for services to vendors a necessary function; and

**WHEREAS**, the contracts proposed for amendment were awarded in accordance with the requirements of the Lane Manual, including the requirements for competitive selection; and


**WHEREAS**, the amendments are necessary to provide for uninterrupted contracted services for necessary County functions, and carry out the established policies of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, these amendments exceed the County Administrator's authority to execute amendments granted in Lane Manual sections 20.600.310,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. That the contract with Womenspace for develop safety plans for and deliver services to victims referred to them by the project will be extended for three years (end date 9/30/2023) at the established contract rates, and
2. That the contract with Womenspace and SASS will work collaboratively to provide training on the intersection between DV and SA for law enforcement, prosecutors, and PO's extending for three (end date 9/30/2023) years at the established contract rates.
3. That the IGA with Lane Council of Governments will provide Grant administration and evaluation assistance project and will be extended for three years (end date 9/30/2023) at the established contract rates, and
