APPLICATION AND AWARD DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office submitted a project to fund Body-Worn Cameras under the FY22 Congressional Directed Spending process; and

WHEREAS, the project was approved and signed into law by President Biden on March 15, 2022 as part of the Federal Budget; and


WHEREAS, the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) is administering the funding; and

WHEREAS, per Lane Manual 20.600.300 D, grant applications and awards in excess of \$150,000 must be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the acceptance of an Office of Community Oriented Policing Services FY22 Technology and Equipment Program award in the amount of \$648,000.
2. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the application and award documents.
