

 2. The Village of Bellevue Park Commission reserves the right to make final determination for acceptance on sponsorship contracts.
 3. The Village of Bellevue reserves the right to revise, reject, or omit any ad at any time without notice. Any camera-ready sponsorship ad or information submitted which does not conform to the publications mechanical requirement will be enlarged, reduced, or floated at the discretion of the department staff.
