




**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS
BEVERLY LANE WATER MAIN EXTENSION**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village Board of the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin has adopted a preliminary resolution declaring its intention to exercise its police power to levy special assessments pursuant to section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., upon property within the proposed assessment district which include two properties (4610 and 4611 Beverly Lane) for benefits conferred upon the property for the construction of the Beverly Lane Water Main Extension Project. The project generally consists of the construction of municipal water main along Beverly Lane starting at 47th Avenue and extending northeast approximately 198-feet in the Village of Pleasant Prairie.

A report, the estimated cost of improvements and a schedule of proposed assessments are on file at the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue, and may be inspected there during any business day between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

You are further notified that the Governing body will hear all interested persons, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and the above described report **at 5:00 p.m. on the 8th day of August, 2022** in the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall. All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the amount of the assessments will be finally determined.
