VIRTUAL MEETING ACCESS AND PARTICIPATION INSTRUCTIONS

If you wish to **participate** during the public comment portion of an agenda item, then you must: Join the meeting using Zoom:

When the Public Comment portion of a case you wish to speak on is open to the public, **you as an attendee must then click the “raise hand” button to indicate to the Chairperson or Secretary that you wish to speak.**

- If you are calling in to access the meeting, you must dial *9 to raise your hand. *6 allows you to mute/unmute.
- After clicking “raise hand” listen for your name, phone number or other ID, given to you during login. Permissions to speak will be then granted to you.
- You cannot participate in public comment unless you are attending the virtual meeting through Zoom.

- All microphones of public users will be muted, except as set forth above during the public comment portion.
