

# WHO YOU GONNA CALL?

Well, don't call Ghostbusters if you have **Storm Water problems**. Also don't call North Little Rock Wastewater. Storm sewers are maintained by the city in which they're located. The storm sewers are the large open grates in streets and near curbs, often at street corners. In North Little Rock call the **Street Department** at 501-340-5356 if you have any concerns regarding storm water.

**Am I located in North Little Rock's Wastewater service area?** NLRW maintains over 700 hundred miles of sewer lines throughout North Little Rock, Maumelle, part of Sherwood and northern Pulaski County. Call the **Engineering Department** at 501-945-7186 to determine if you are in our service area.

**What can I dump into a sewer or down my drain?** Do NOT put out-of-date medicines, grease, fibrous wipes of any type into the sewer. Don't flush these items. The toilet is not a trash can. Call **North Little Rock Wastewater** at 501-945-7186 and request special lids for storing grease which can then be put out with your trash. The **Regional Recycling & Waste Reduction District** operates drop-off stations for chemicals. Call 501-340-8787 for more information. If you have paint that is still usable, contact **Habitat for Humanity**, in North Little Rock. The ReStore is located at 2657 Pike Avenue, 501-771-9497. Call **Arkansas Takeback** at 501-618-8175 for a list of locations near you where expired drugs have safe disposal.

**Who is responsible when my pipes back up?** Property owners are responsible for their sewer lines to the point where they connect to the city main. When a back-up is experienced, it's a good idea to call **NLRW** at 501-945-7186 and request the **Maintenance Department** check the line. This may save an unnecessary and expensive plumbing bill.
