What if I already have a home blood glucose monitor?

What if I am unsure how to use my new monitor?

You will receive directions with your shipment. You can also call the SCL Diabetic Program to receive instructions over the phone, in English or Spanish.

How do I get started?

What should I do when it is time to reorder my prescription and supplies?

An SCL Diabetic Program representative will call you at home once every 90 days to inventory your medication or supplies and replenish them accordingly. They will verify your order and health coverage before mailing your next shipment. If you have moved, or your phone number has changed, please notify the SCL Diabetic Program promptly so they can continue the reorder service uninterrupted.
