



22-23 Girl Scouts Troop Specialist AmeriCorps Member

The Girl Scout Troop Specialist AmeriCorps Member will support Girl Scouts' missions by serving girls through in-school, after-school, and community group settings by providing the Girl Scout Leadership Experience. The AmeriCorps Member will enhance the current program by establishing programs in areas where youth face significant barriers to joining Girl Scouts. By bringing the Girl Scout program right to them, girls who may have otherwise not had the opportunity can learn about STEM, the outdoors, life skills, and entrepreneurship.

TERM OF SERVICE: September 6, 2022 – August 19, 2023

MINIMUM HOURS OF SERVICE: **900 hours** 18 hours a week, between the hours of 9am – 5pm weekdays (service times may be flexible based on member's availability).

LIVING ALLOWANCE: \$9,000.00 **EDUCATION AWARD AT COMPLETION OF SERVICE:** \$3,247.50

SITE SPECIFIC SERVICE ACTIVITIES:

- Plan and implement two to three programs and five special events to serve and engage girls who face significant barriers to joining Girl Scouts. The Girl Scouts Community Engagement Managers will be available if questions arise.
- Facilitate council wide recruitment events to include:
 - Design, print, and deliver flyers
 - Phone calls to schools to set up girls talks (to be done in person or virtually)
 - Communicate and connect with service unit volunteers
 - Prepping supplies needed for events
 - Attend all Recruitment Events
- Serve with Girl Scouts office staff to organize and distribute troop supplies
- Prep, lead, and facilitate troop meetings* bi-weekly from February to October
* held in locations easily accessible to the girls (community centers, schools, or churches)
- Complete all required paperwork/reports within required deadlines.
- Travel throughout assigned geographic areas

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience working with youth and adults.
- Requires basic ability with Microsoft Office, Word, Excel, and Outlook
- Valid driver's license with good driving record.
- Access to reliable transportation.
- Proof of vehicle insurance.
- Belief in and supports the mission of the Girl Scouts.
