Site Specific Service Activities:

- Maintain a safe and caring environment for camp participants grades Kindergarten-5th grade by:
 - Create and complete a daily risk and safety checklist
 - Provide community resources and referrals to students who need social, emotional, and economic supports
 - Attend field trip activities to enhance child safety, as well as expand upon the child's knowledge of community resources
- Be a positive role model for camp participants by
 - Modeling appropriate behavior including civic responsibility, community action, and relationship building
 - Taking an interest in each child as a unique individual and show shared interest in what they care about
 - Help children resolve conflicts appropriately
 - Work one-on-one with children who are having difficulty participating in the program
- Create and be an active participant in camp activities by
 - Carry out developmental activities that promote skill building in the areas of teamwork, sportsmanship, respect, etc.

- Use group management skills to engage all children
