### FIELD MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN II

#### DEFINITION

Under general supervision, performs a variety of skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled tasks in the construction, maintenance, or repair of City streets or water systems, and related facilities and equipment; directs the work of others in the absence of the Field Maintenance Technician III; performs such other duties as may be assigned.

#### CLASS CHARACTERISTICS

This position works under general supervision in the performance of skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled work. It is distinguished from the class of Field Maintenance Technician I by both knowledge/skill level, and responsibility for the direction of others on a project basis. As such, only one position in each crew may be allocated to the Field Maintenance Technician II class.

#### EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

1. Depending on assignment, duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:
2. Performs skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled work in the construction, maintenance, or repair of City streets, grounds and landscaped areas; and related facilities and equipment.
3. Operates or may direct the operation of light to heavy power-driven equipment in completion of the assigned tasks.
4. Tasks may include the construction, repair or maintenance of City streets, street lighting and storm drain systems; for trimming and removal of street trees; grounds and landscaped areas; and related facilities and equipment.
5. Performs or may direct the maintenance or repair of Division facilities and equipment.
6. When assigned, directs the work of others involved in related construction, maintenance or repair activity; provides instruction in work performance, in accordance with safe work practices.
7. Responds to calls when off duty.
8. Other duties as may be assigned

#### QUALIFICATIONS GUIDELINES

##### Education and/or Experience

Any combination of education and/or experience that has provided the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary for satisfactory job performance. Example combinations include five to seven years of experience in related construction, maintenance and repair activity which included the operation of power-driven equipment.

### Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Considerable knowledge of the practices and materials used in the construction, maintenance, or repair of City streets, street lighting and storm drain systems; for trimming and removal of street trees; grounds and landscaped areas; and related facilities and equipment; safe work practices.

Working knowledge of related laws, ordinances, rules and regulations. Skill in the operation of a variety of light to heavy power-driven equipment.

Ability to perform skilled construction, maintenance, and repair tasks; read and interpret plans; understand and follow verbal and written directions; direct the work of others and provide instructions in the absence of direct supervision; establish and maintain cooperative working relationships.

### Special Requirements

Possession of or ability to obtain an appropriate California driver's license, and a satisfactory driving record.

Incumbents must pass a medical examination at the time of appointment.

### WORKING CONDITIONS

The work environment involves high risks with exposure to potentially dangerous situations or unusual environmental risks which require a range of safety and other precautions. The work requires considerable and strenuous physical exertion such as frequent climbing, lifting of objects weighing in excess of 74 pounds, moving in areas of difficult or dangerous access, and in varying weather conditions.
