

Additional Nominations accepted between 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on **August 24, 2022**

Nominations will be accepted for the offices of:

- Councillor for the Town of Blind River (six to be elected, five are acclaimed)

Nomination forms may be filed at the Town of Blind River Clerk's department, 11 Hudson St., on August 24, 2022 between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. The term of elected office will be from December 1, 2022, to November 14, 2026.

Under Section 29(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended – A person may be nominated for an office only if, as of the day the person is nominated:

- a. he or she is qualified to hold that office under the Act that creates it; and
- b. he or she is not ineligible under this or any other Act or otherwise prohibited by law to be nominated for or to hold the office.

Nomination and the declaration of qualification forms will be available in the Clerk's department and on the town's election website at [Blindriver.ca/town_hall/municipal_elections_2022](https://www.blindriver.ca/town_hall/municipal_elections_2022). The following must be provided at the time of submission:

- A completed nomination form;
- A declaration of qualification by the candidate;
- The prescribed nomination filing fee payable to the Town of Blind River, in the amount of \$100 for Councillor and for all other offices; and
- Candidate identification (driver's licence or other government issued photo identification containing the qualifying address and signature).

A person may not accept contributions for election purposes, or incur expenses, until that person has filed a nomination paper with the Town Clerk.
