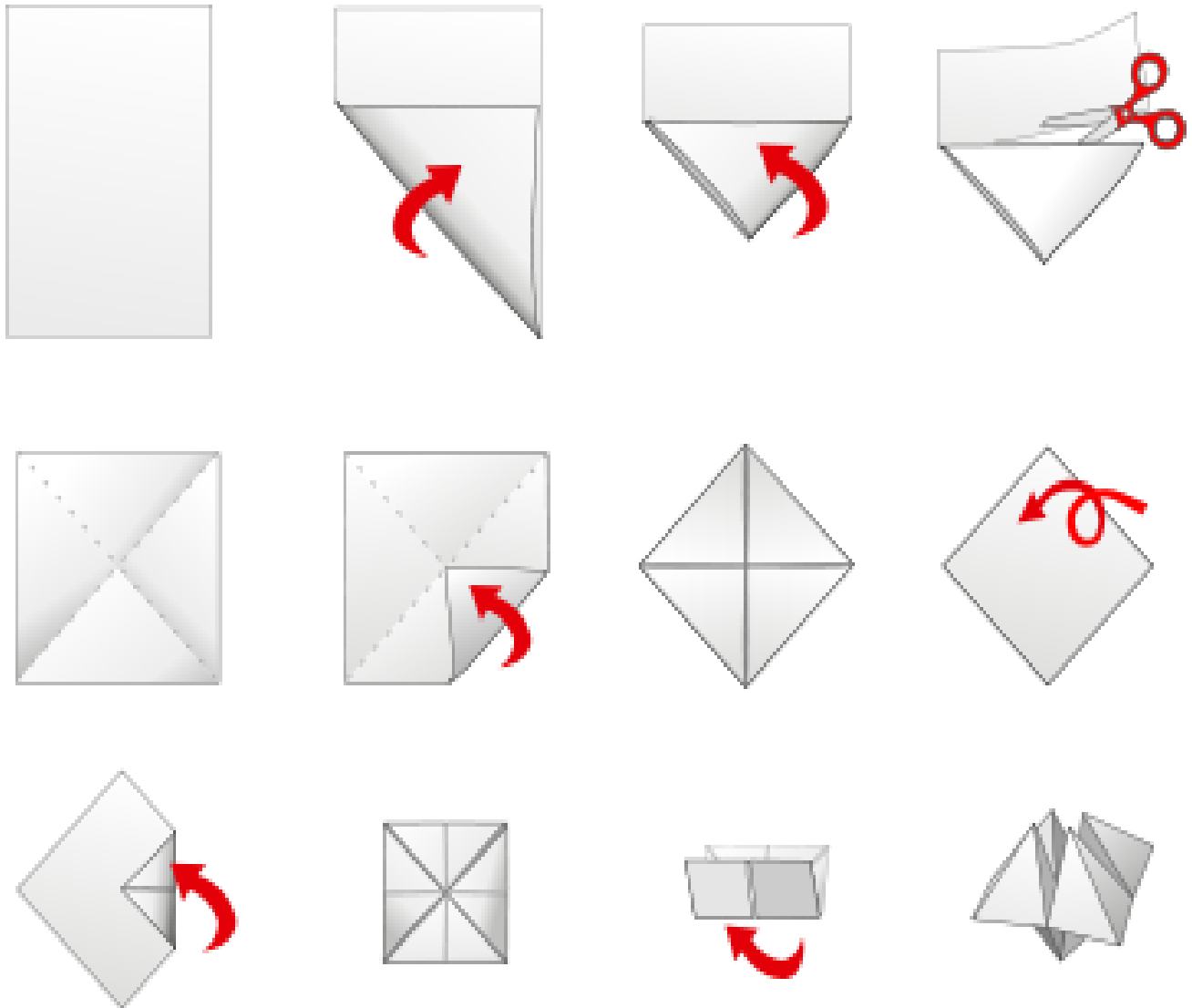

Origami Whirly-Bird

First, with the whirly-bird closed, choose one of the four squares – rain, earth, leak or glass. Then spell the word, close-and-open the whirly-bird once for each letter in the word, leaving it open at the end so that you see four colors inside.

(When you open and close it, open it once with your forefinger and thumb on each hand together. Then open it with your two forefingers together and your two thumbs together.)

Second, choose one of the four colors, and close-and-open the whirly-bird for as many letters in the color you picked, again ending with it open.

Last, choose one of the four colors, and lift up that flap to reveal a way you can help conserve water.
