Program Qualifications

Have a City of Roseville Water Utility account

Submit a completed application form

Submit to a Pre-inspection appointment with the City of Roseville prior to replacing toilet

Replace a 1.6 gallons per flush (GPF) or higher toilet with a single flush 1.28 GPF or less or with a dual flush model with 1.28/.8 GPF or less

Replace a 1.28 GPF with a .8 GPF single flush model or dual flush model with 1.28/.8 GPF or less

New toilets purchased must be WaterSense approved. Qualifying models can be found at www.epa.gov/watersense/products/toilets.html. Please note: EPA approved models must meet both requirements listed above to qualify

The entire toilet must be replaced (tank and bowl)

Provide a copy of the paid receipt. Receipt must be dated within 90 days of purchase

Submit to a Post-inspection of the newly installed toilet with the City of Roseville

Qualifying Options (You must choose one):

Replacing a 1.6 GPF model with a 1.28 GPF (or lower) model

Replacing a 1.28 GPF model with a .8 GPF single flush model or dual flush model with a 1.28/.8 GPF or less (Dual flush models with a 1.6 flush capacity do not qualify)

The City of Roseville will not be held liable for any toilets replaced with non-qualifying models.

Residential Toilet Rebate Program Terms and Conditions

A. Toilet rebate program overview:

- The program will assist home owners that are billed on a residential rate structure with costs related to replacement of their older, non-conserving toilets with newer, more efficient models.
- This program is available from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, pending council approval. This program is subject to budget funding each fiscal year. Rebates are “first come, first served” and will continue until all toilet and urinal rebates have been awarded each funded year.
- The City of Roseville will rebate up to \$100.00 for qualifying models.
- Applicants must have a pre-inspection completed by the City of Roseville prior to toilet replacement.
- Covered rebate expenses include the tank & bowl along with any accessories that come with it, i.e., supply line, wax ring, caulking, seat, bolts, bolt covers, in addition to tax, and professional installation. The maximum rebate will not exceed \$100.00 per qualifying model.
- Applicants must provide a copy of a paid receipt. The receipt must be dated within 90 days of purchase.
- Applicants must have a post-inspection completed by the City of Roseville once the toilet has been replaced.

B. Who is eligible to participate in this program:

- Site address must receive City of Roseville water in order to qualify. Utility account must be in good standing to qualify.
- Applicant must meet all of the requirements listed on the Residential Toilet Rebate application. The City of Roseville is not responsible for equipment purchased or work performed in conjunction with this program.

C. How to participate:

- After the application has been received a Water Efficiency Staff member will contact you to set up an inspection date and time.
- Do not remove or destroy your existing high flush toilets until an inspection has been performed.
