Funding for this program has been provided in full or in part from the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014 and through an agreement with the State Department of Water Resources.

Section 1. Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions apply to the Outdoor Efficiency Upgrade Program. Please read carefully prior to submission of any application.

1. This program is available from July 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023. Incentives are “first come, first served”. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City of Roseville reserves the rights to terminate this program at any time, for any reason. Application submissions must be made between July 1, 2022 and September 30, 2023 and all repairs completed prior to November 30, 2023.
2. Applicant must be a City of Roseville water utility account holder. Utility account must be in good standing.
3. Site must have a water meter installed and billed on a metered rate for at least 12 months to be eligible.
4. Applicant must be the homeowner of record and occupy the property. Non-owner occupied properties do not qualify.
5. One application may be submitted per household.
6. This program is designed to encourage water savings. Rebates are only available to improve existing in-ground irrigation systems and/or automatic timers. New irrigation system installations are not eligible.
7. Applicant must submit a completed application and have a pre-inspection performed by a City of Roseville representative, with authorization to proceed prior to completing upgrades.
8. Qualifying upgrades to be determined by City of Roseville representative prior to work being completed. Any project that is started before the customer water use survey is performed is not eligible for a rebate.
9. The maximum rebate for irrigation system efficiency upgrades is \$500 per residential meter. Rebate may include materials and labor (installation) costs. Material cost per unit must not exceed manufacturer’s suggested retail price. Installation is the sole responsibility of the applicant. If the applicant chooses to hire a vendor to complete the work, in order to be eligible for labor reimbursement, the work must be completed by a licensed plumber or licensed irrigation contractor holding a State of California C27, D12, or C36 license – no exceptions. To confirm that a contractor holds a valid license visit www.cslb.ca.gov.
10. Installation costs from a licensed landscape contractor can be reimbursed through this Program for up to \$150 per residential meter for a total rebate not to exceed above limits of \$500. In order to receive reimbursement for installation costs, a detailed invoice from a licensed landscape contractor with itemized material and labor costs must be submitted to the water provider. Self-installation by a residential or CII property owner/staff may not received reimbursement for installation costs.
11. Rebates may be given for water efficient equipment and labor for installation of water efficient equipment. Incidental supplies such as couplings, wiring, electrical tape, etc. are excluded from rebate funding.
12. Eligible irrigation equipment upgrades include equipment that improves irrigation efficiency as determined by the City of Roseville. Upgrades may include:
 - Weather/soil based smart irrigation controller (Controller must be on the SWAT-tested list, which can be found at www.irrigation.org/swat/ and/or WaterSense labeled list (where applicable), which can be found <https://lookforwatersense.epa.gov/products/>)
 - Equipment that upgrades standard irrigation timers to smart timers (i.e., rain sensor, moisture sensors, weather stations, etc.)
 - Matched precipitation rate sprinkler heads equipped with pressure reducing devices or check valves to standardize all equipment within systems.
 - Installing check valves in low lying sprinklers to prevent excess drainage
 - Drip irrigation equipment: converting existing non-turf spray equipment to low volume drip. Note: Microspray systems do not meet the terms of the Program. Drip systems must be separated from overhead spray heads with an independent valve.
 - Convert standard spray type nozzles to low precipitation, high distribution uniformity or multi-stream rotator nozzles with a flow rate of 1.10 inches per hour
 - Pressure regulation equipment for irrigation system
13. To receive the rebate, applicant must submit all required documentation, including itemized receipts, and have a post-inspection survey by a City of Roseville representative once upgrades are completed. The City of Roseville is entitled to fully review all reported labor and materials costs and reserve the right to deny reimbursement to any applicant for extraneous costs. Approved participants should contact the City in advance of making a purchasing commitment if they are uncertain whether the costs are eligible.
14. Submit copy of paid, itemized receipt dated within 30 days of repairs (parts and labor must be listed separately).

15. Schedule and pass a post inspection with the City of Roseville to verify qualifying upgrades.
16. Rebate program is subject to available funding. Incentives will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is depleted. Submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate.

17. City reserves the right to modify or cancel the program at any time.

Section 2: Submission Instructions

1. Submit complete application to the City of Roseville. Applications may be sent electronically or via regular mail. **For any questions regarding the application or rebate process, call 916-774-5761.**

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2. Once the application has been received and rebate funds have been identified, a representative will contact you to schedule a customer water use survey, which includes and audit of your outdoor irrigation system (may be done virtually).
3. Once the customer water use survey has been completed, the City of Roseville will provide you with a list of the irrigation efficiency upgrade equipment/materials that are approved for purchase and eligible for a rebate. Both you and the City representative approve the customer water use survey form.
4. The purchase and installation of all approved equipment must be completed within 120 days from the date of the customer water use survey form and no later than November 30, 2023, whichever comes first.
5. You must provide the customer water use survey form and original receipts to the City of Roseville. Submission of the receipts and form are required to be eligible for a rebate under this Program. If a contractor purchased the materials, you must request a detailed invoice showing separate line items for materials and labor.
