LCpl Jeremy S. Lasher, 27, of Oneida, New York was killed in action on July 23rd 2009 while deployed to Helmand Province Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. He died from wounds sustained from an Improvised Explosive Device. He was assigned to Weapons Company, 2nd Battalion 8th Marines Regiment, 2nd Marine Division based out of Camp Lejeune, NC. His previous combat deployment includes Iraq 2007-2008 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Before joining the Marine Corps in October, 2006, Jeremy was very outgoing and known as the one who would give the shirt off his back. He loved spending time with family and friends, enjoying skateboarding, rollerblading, snowmobiling, drawing, art, and music. He had a passion for landscaping design and gardening. Jeremy was also an enthusiastic member of the Verona Volunteer Fire Department. He leaves behind his wife Andrea, son Caden, parents Scott and Vicky, sister Jennifer and her husband Kyle, now living in Marysville, WA, brother Ryan and his wife Kelly. Jeremy also leaves behind nephews Curtis, Cooper and Colton, nieces Jordan and Iris.
