

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

CITY OF STATESVILLE

AMITY HILL ROAD AND SHELTON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS

Sealed bids for the project entitled **Amity Hill Road and Shelton Avenue Improvements** will be received by the **City of Statesville** until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **Thursday, October 17th, 2019** in the **Council Chambers of the City Hall Building**. At said place and time, all Bids that have been duly received, will be publicly opened and read aloud.

THE PROJECT GENERALLY CONSISTS OF: Realignment of approximately 800 LF of Amity Hill Road to intersect Shelton Avenue approximately 700 feet south of the current intersection together with addition of approximately 500 feet of right turn lane along Shelton Avenue, together with associated demolition, grading, drainage, erosion control, paving, pavement markings, sidewalks, and signage improvements.

Prospective bidders must register and obtain an official set of the Bidding Documents. Digital copies of Bid Documents are available for purchase at www.mcgillengineers.com for a fee of \$100.00 per set. These documents may be downloaded by selecting this project from the "Bids" link and by entering the appropriate Quest Project number 6530306. Bids received from bidders who are not registered planholders with the Engineer will not be accepted or opened. Each bid shall be accompanied with a cash deposit or certified check drawn on a bank or trust company insured by the FDIC or a Bid Bond prepared on the form of Bid Bond contained in the Bidding Documents or a Surety Company's standard form and properly executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds. The amount of the bid bond shall be equal to **five (5) percent** of the total of the bid. The bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful bidder fails to execute the contract or fails to provide the required bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after the proper notice of award of the contract.

Bidders must comply with the requirements of the State of North Carolina and be appropriately licensed as a Contractor as provided in General Statutes Chapter 87.

Bidders are encouraged to only secure project bid documents as noted above. Neither the Owner nor the Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any source other than the Engineer and their representative plan provider, QuestCDN. Each Bidder shall be responsible for the review of all addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive informalities, or to reject non-conforming, non-responsive, or conditional bids. The Owner reserves the right to award a contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder or bidders, taking into consideration quality, performance and time.

The **City of Statesville** has adopted “Guidelines for Recruitment and Selection of Minority Businesses for Participation in the City of Statesville Building Construction Contracts”. The minority participation goal is 10% by historically underutilized businesses (HUB) in construction projects as defined in GS 143-128. Equal access and opportunity to participate in all aspects of construction project shall be provided to HUB. It is the policy of the City of Statesville to award public building contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or disabling condition. Each bidder shall make a good faith effort and shall document such efforts to utilize minority businesses and comply with the Resolution.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours Standard Act, and 40 CFR 33.1016, and 40 CFR 60-4.
