



Project streets are shown in green (mill and overlay) and orange (reclaim and overlay). A majority of the work is located in the Lions Park neighborhood, pictured to the right. Erickson Drive, south of 49th Avenue will also be reclaimed and overlaid, shown above.

Oregon Avenue between 40th and 42nd: on the west side of the roadway, there is an aging storm sewer utility pipe. This pipe was bid to either be replaced or repaired as part of this project. The repair alternative was selected during the bid process due to significant cost savings and reduction of impact to property. The repair involves lining the existing pipe, which is a process that is done without excavating and exposing the pipe.

Oregon Avenue between 38th and 39th: the water main in this area is failing and requires replacement. The water main replacement will not have significant impact on driveways or yards, but during the replacement there will be access impacts, which will be communicated directly with affected residents.

Maryland and 38th Avenue Intersection: drainage improvements will be installed in this intersection. This intersection is currently a low spot, but with no storm drains to drain water. Drains will be installed and connected to the drainage system in Lions Park.

Louisiana Avenue between 36th and Markwood Dr: This portion of Louisiana Avenue will be reconstructed by the city of Crystal. Water main and storm sewer will be replaced. A sidewalk will be installed along the west side of Louisiana Avenue, between 36th Avenue and the first driveway. Otherwise, there will be minimal impacts to property's, but there will be periodic closures during construction.
